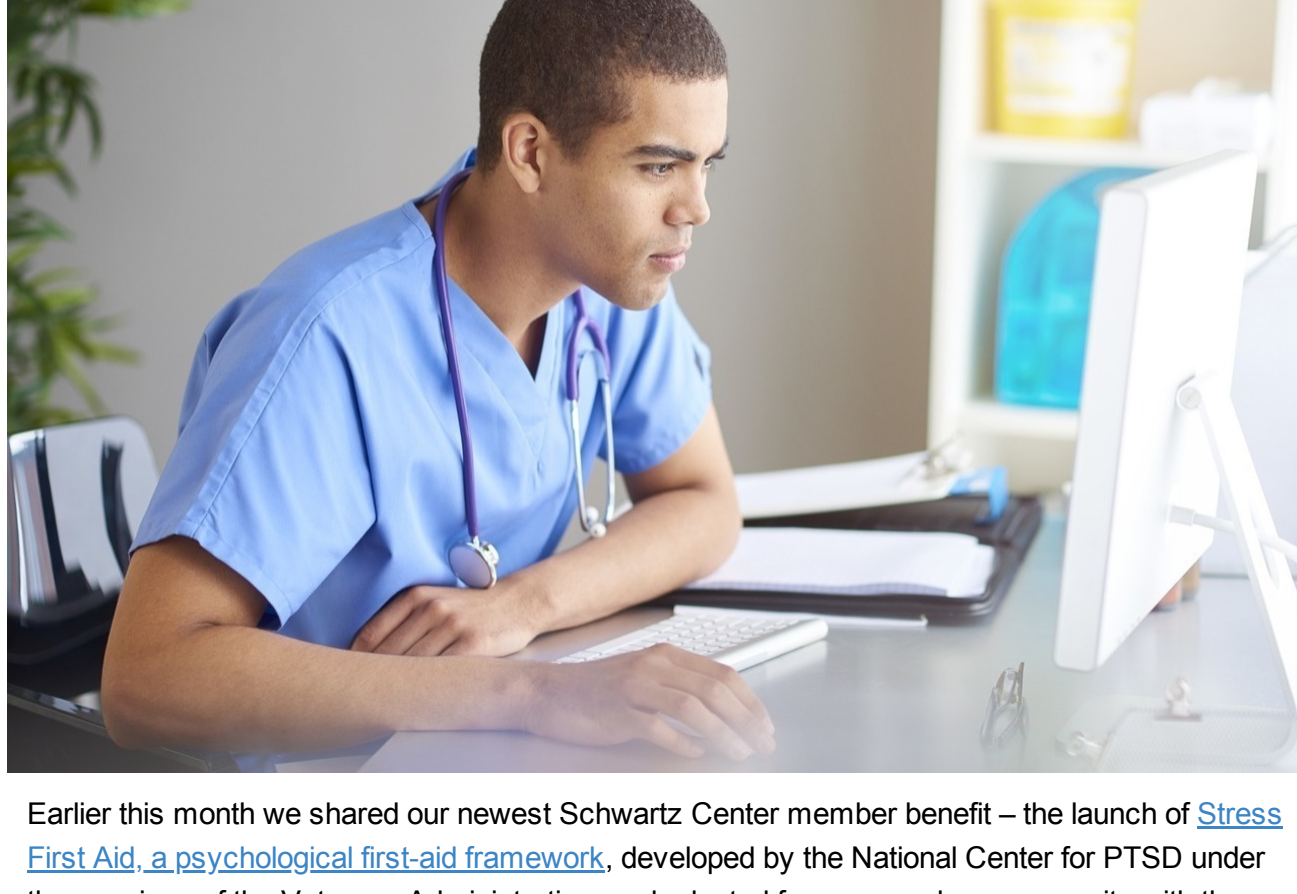

NEW - Stress First Aid Training Program



Earlier this month we shared our newest Schwartz Center member benefit – the launch of [Stress First Aid, a psychological first-aid framework](#), developed by the National Center for PTSD under the auspices of the Veterans Administration, and adapted for our member community with the support of NCPTSD psychologist Dr. Patricia Watson. Many of you may have learned about Stress First Aid (SFA) during our [Compassion in Action webinars](#).

Stress First Aid offers a set of supportive actions that promote self-care and peer support, enabling teams to identify and mitigate the negative impacts of stress at work before they impair staff health and wellbeing. The SFA model is based on five evidence-informed factors that help people recover from stress and adversity: the need for safety, calm, connection, a sense of competence or self-efficacy, and hope.

There are two SFA training options:

- [A one-hour introductory course](#) that introduces the basics of Stress First Aid for healthcare workers. This course is available to all staff at your organization.
- **An eight-hour Train the Trainer course** that will provide you with the tools and resources needed to plan to implement SFA at your organization. This training includes eight modules of self-paced online instruction complemented by three web-based meetings with your training cohort and a Schwartz Center staff member. Schwartz Rounds® Training and Education Schedule

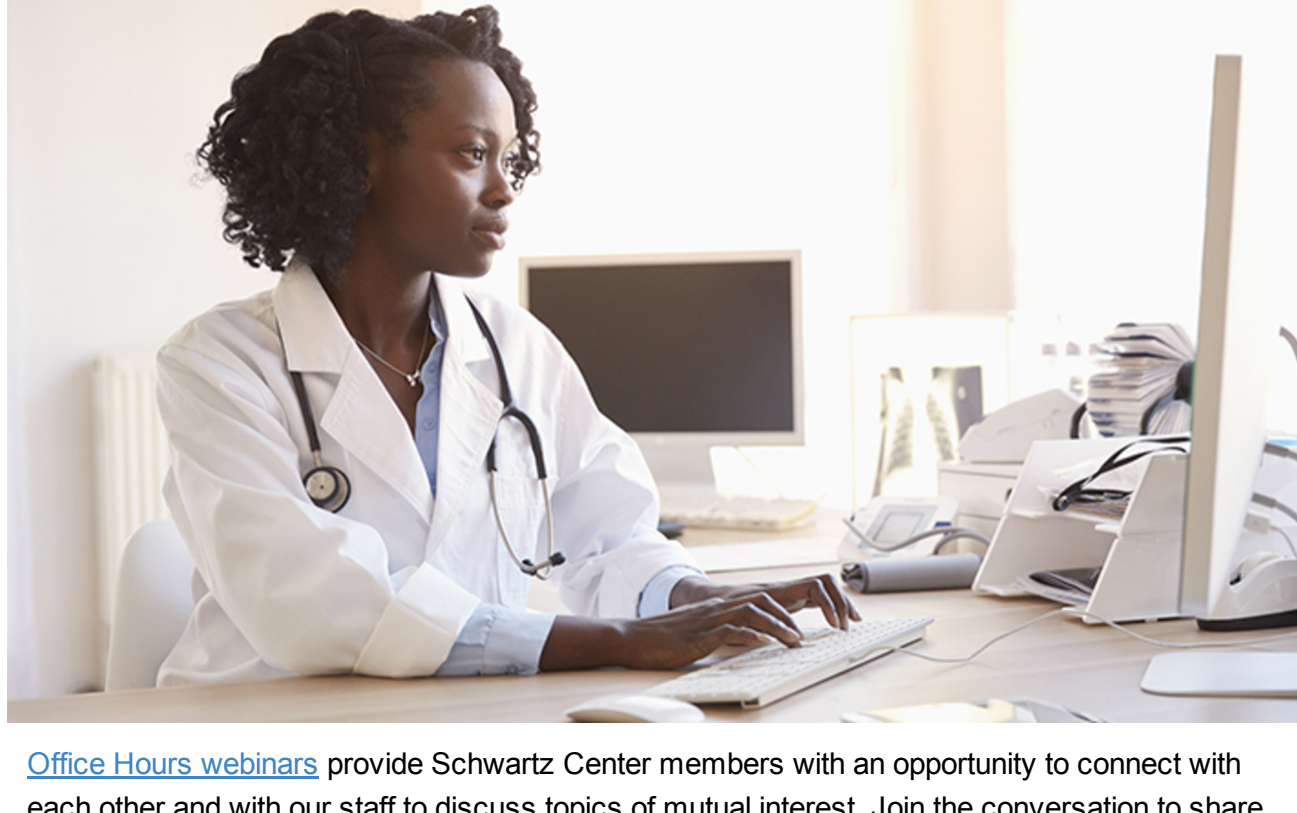
