Virtual Schwartz Rounds



We know that Schwartz Rounds offer a unique forum for convening and supporting each other. With the onset of the COVID-19 pandemic, many members asked us about convening Schwartz Rounds sessions on virtual meeting platforms until we can convene in person again. The Schwartz Center team put a great deal of thought into the potential risks and benefits of offering Schwartz Rounds in this context. As a result, we created <u>Guidance for Virtual Schwartz Rounds</u> recognizing that this variation does not and cannot replicate our in-person Schwartz Rounds sessions but hope it will provide you with a means to continue fostering the connection and compassion that the program is built on and help sustain you during this time.

If you're interested in implementing this variation of Schwartz Rounds, **we encourage you to participate in our hourlong training webinar.** <u>During the session</u>, we'll discuss how to plan and facilitate your Virtual Schwartz Rounds, and how to leverage technology in our pursuit of community and compassion, leaving plenty of time for Q&A.

Unit-Based Schwartz Rounds



Earlier this year we launched <u>Unit-Based Schwartz Rounds (UBSR</u>), a complement to the Schwartz Rounds program. UBSR brings the program's support to the point of care at the time of need. It allows organizations to offer a smaller, more intimate forum for essential conversations about the social-emotional experience of caregiving. As your organization allows, this variation may be one way to slowly move toward in-person gatherings once again while enabling access to a different kind of conversation.
